## **NU-WAY STOVE**

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE – MODEL 2000 GAS STOVE**

Equipped for use with propane gas only. Cylinder should be placed outside of shelter or building with a minimum of 24 inches between cylinder and stove. Gas supply must be turned off when not in use. Manufacturer recommends pre-burning stove for 15 minutes before occupying shanty or blind on first use.

(1) Vent stove to the outside using 3 inch stovepipe for a chimney. Chimney should reach 2 feet above the highest point of the shelter. This unit is equipped with a built-in draft diverter. If you require more heat from this unit, install a 3" cast iron damper in the first section of the stove pipe. Keep at least 4 feet of stove pipe inside the shelter before exiting.


(2) A clearance of at least 9 inches between stove or flue pipe and any combustible material must be maintained. Place stove on a non-combustible surface.

(3) Stove must have fresh air supply into the enclosure when stove is in use. A 6" hole is recommended.

(4) Attach wire door handle (Part #4) to door.

(5) Attach gas valve knob (Part #5) to valve stem.

(6) Attach the stove manifold (Part #3) to propane cylinder. YOU MUST USE A GAS REGULATOR (11 Inches W.C. regulator is recommended). Nu-Way Stove Inc., or your local L.P. gas dealer can supply the regulator, hose, and fittings needed to perform this step. The hose and fittings must all be leak free. Check fittings with soap solution before each use.



(7) LIGHTING INSTRUCTIONS: To light stove, turn on gas supply at tank. To open stove valve, DEPRESS KNOB (Part #5) and turn 1/8 turn to the left. Place a lighted match near the top of the burner and DEPRESS PLUNGER for approximately one minute, or until stove stays on after plunger is released. If flame goes out, turn off stove valve immediately and repeat instructions.
